“A steady flow of knowledge”

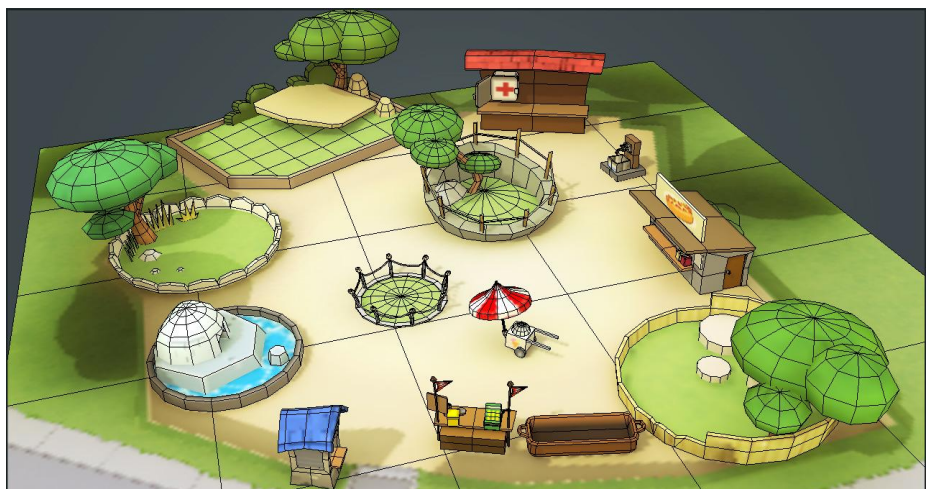
Science: The students have been learning about the double helix, DNA. We discovered the genetic background of Harry Potter.
